

The **Boys Basketball team**, led by coaches Jim Victor, Warren Stowe, Gerry Klos and Tom Bowdell defeated Wyandotte both times this year and some other notable wins were against Trenton, Inter-City, Melvindale, and Kennedy. The team played at Little Caesars Arena where they defeated Carlson, advanced to the District semi-finals in the MHSAA playoffs and finished with a 14-7 overall record.

They also tied Trenton (who advanced to the state finals) and remained undefeated against them for the third straight season. The team won the Allen Park Thanksgiving Classic with wins over Carlson and Woodhaven, advanced in the MHSAA playoffs to the Regional Final (Sweet Sixteen) and finished with a 14-9-4 overall record.

The **Boys Wrestling team**, led by coaches Dan Loyd, Bob Loyd, Larry Cervantes and Bobby Webb had some big victories by defeating Riverview and Trenton twice this year with other wins against Lincoln Park, Edsel Ford, Stoney Creek and others. In the MHSAA team playoffs, they defeated both Trenton and Riverview to win the MHSAA District Championship for the first time since 2003 and only the second title in school history! Then in the MHSAA Individual District meet, Chad Johnson, Christian Good, Tyler Miracle and Joe Dudley advanced on and qualified for the MHSAA Regional. Chad Johnson then earned a third place bronze medal finish in the Regional and qualified for the MHSAA State Final Meet held at Ford Field.

The **Girls Basketball team**, led by coaches Chuck Perez and Adrienne Richards defeated Truman, Southgate, Kennedy, Lincoln Park and Carlson both times this season. They also had big wins over Wyandotte and Woodhaven and the team won the MHSAA District Championship for the third time in the past five years. They advanced to the Regional Semi-finals (Top 32 in the State) and finished with a 14-9 overall record.

The **Boys Swim team**, led by coaches Chris Maurino, McKenna Maurino and Paul LaCroix had another year of breaking school records on their way to an undefeated dual meet season and a Downriver League Championship! The team had 8 swimmers and 2 divers qualify for the MHSAA State Finals meet this season with Bruce Liepe, Noah Barstad, Vincent Martinez and Victor Martinez in the 200yd. freestyle relay; Jacob Stibel, Noah Barstad, Vincent Martinez and Victor Martinez in the 200 medley relay; Christopher Watson and Bruce Liepe in the 50 free; Bruce Liepe in the 100 free; Vincent and Victor Martinez in the 100 breaststroke; Victor Martinez in the 200 IM; Jacob Stibel in the 100 back; Bruce Liepe, Christopher Watson, Aaron Knoch and Geoffrey Honeycutt in the 400 free relay; and Alexander Alvarez and Brendan Wilkes in diving. Three school records were broken with Bruce Liepe in the 50 free; Christopher Watson, Noah Barstad, Vincent Martinez and Bruce Liepe in the 200 free relay; and Jacob Stibel, Noah Barstad, Vincent Martinez and Bruce Liepe in the 200 medley relay. The team earned so many points while at the State Final meet that they achieved a Top 13 finish!

They then advanced to the next week where they became Regional Champions for the first time since 2010. With that win they qualified for the MHSAA State Final Meet for the 14th year in a row. At States, they finished with three clean rounds and became Runner-up Champions and one of the top two teams in the state for three consecutive years! This also marked the 14th consecutive season as one of the top five teams in the state.
